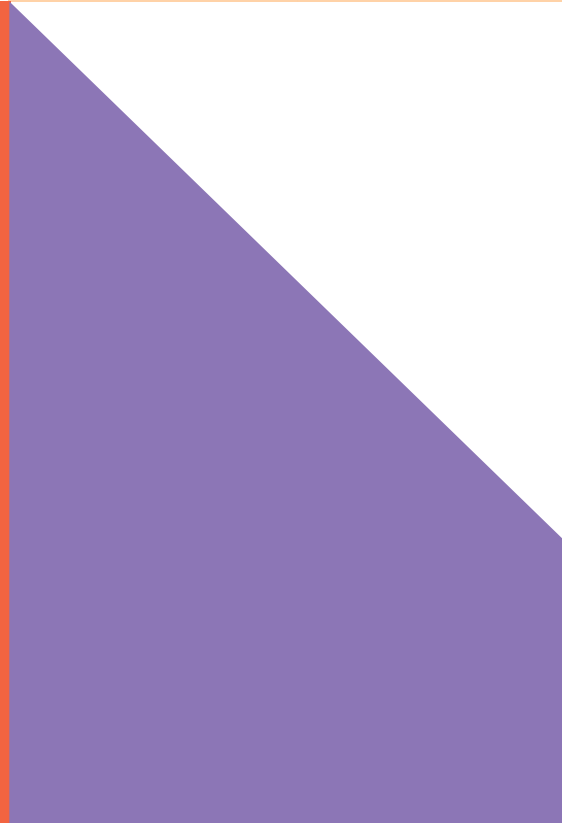
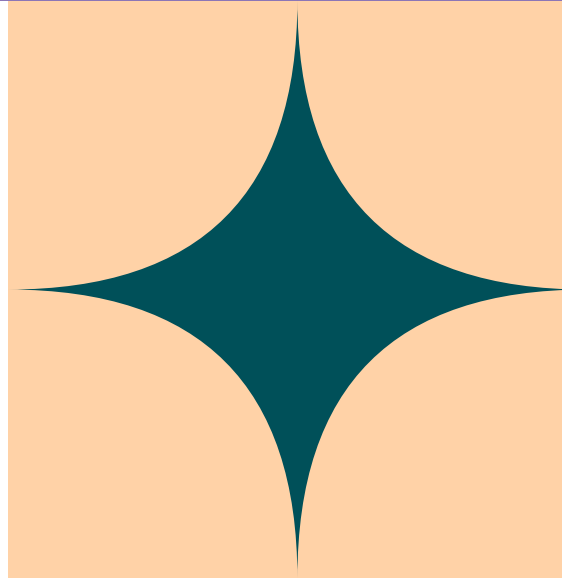

Unveiling Our Core Values

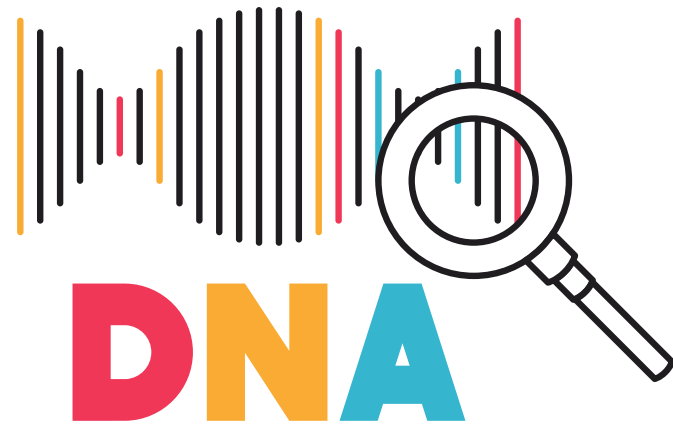
What are our collective DCFC values? What defines us as a community of faith?

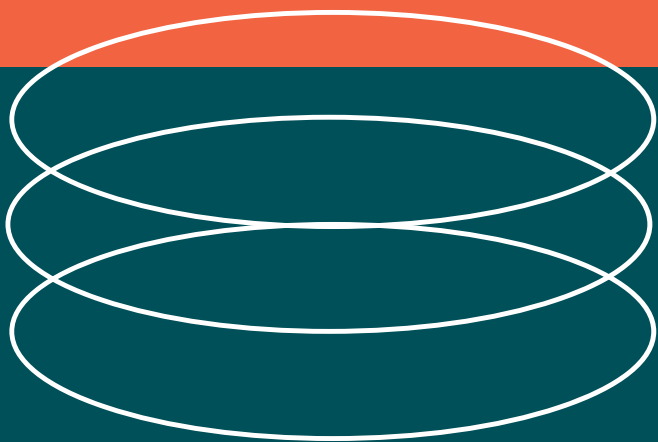
Word Centered

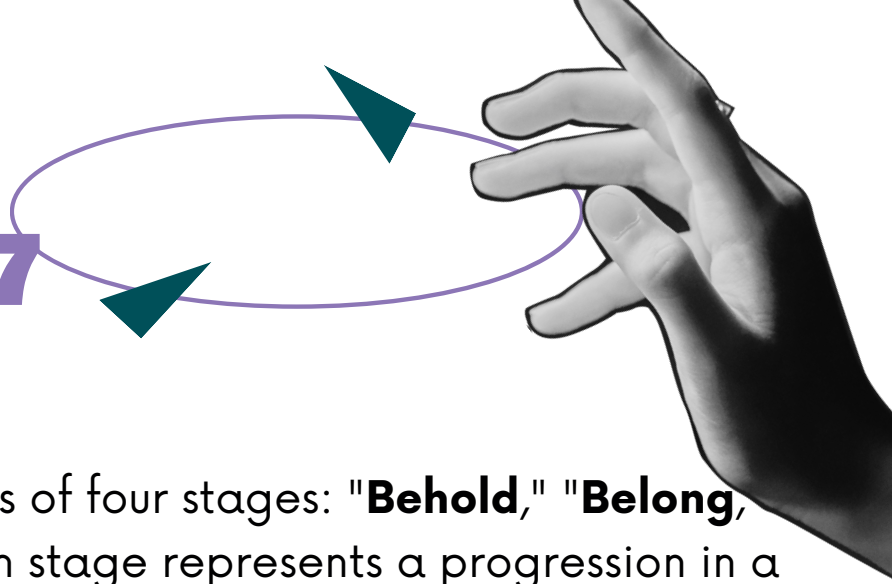

2024 - 2027 THEMES

Each year we will spend intentional time in learning more about how we can collectively and individually **behold** our God, **belong** to the body, **become** like Christ, and go **beyond** our walls.

WHAT IS THE DISCIPLE'S PATHWAY?

Our themes challenge us to move beyond complacency and toward a depth in our walk with God.

In essence, the Disciple's Pathway isn't a passive stroll; it's an active, intentional journey towards a mature Christian life. It beckons us to be convicted, to pursue Christ with zeal, and to live out our faith in ways that leave a lasting impact on the world.

THEMES FOR 2024 - 2027

DISCIPLE'S PATHWAY

1

Behold - 2024

"Behold" challenges us to seek Him individually and collectively with fervor, to immerse ourselves in His Presence. We behold God in corporate weekly worship and in our private daily devotion to Him.

2

Belong - 2025

"Belong" challenges us to actively engage with our church family, to support and be supported, and to share in the joys and struggles of faith together.

3

Become - 2026

"Become" challenges us to delve deeply into Scripture, discipleship, prayer, and other spiritual disciplines, to fight our flesh and renew our mind. It's a journey towards Christlikeness and joy in God.

4

Beyond - 2027

"Beyond" calls us to be the hands and feet of Jesus, to serve others selflessly, and to boldly share the Gospel with those around us both locally and globally. This stage challenges us to step outside of our comfort zones and embrace the Great Commission in the spirit of the Great Commandment.

1

Encourage personal, family, and corporate worship.

Our desire is that we would allow God to grow us from the inside out, first within our daily devotional life, our household (marriage, family, roommates), and then in our corporate weekly Sunday worship.

2

Call fellowship members to worship

Sunday services provide a dedicated time for collective worship, reflection, and spiritual growth, complementing the warm fellowship during the week.

3

Encourage daily Bible reading

We need to daily pursue God in His Word to worship Him and become more like Him.
